KSRTC unveils the first of its kind 'Open Data' Programme to disseminate Mysuru bus information

For the first time in the history of State Road Transport Undertakings, as a value addition, KSRTC is disseminating the Mysuru bus operational data (both Static and Real Time) as per International norms of General Transit Feed Specification (GTFS) pattern under the ITS Open Data Programme.

Start-ups and other businesses could harness the data to devise new services that not only boost commerce, but also spur KSRTC's ridership.

Interested parties willing to obtain Mysore ITS bus operational data under Open Data Policy are informed to register by visiting ITS portal **mitra.ksrtc.in**, read all the terms of use, follow the instructions provided thereof and submit online request form to KSRTC from 06-05-2018 onwards. Subsequently, KSRTC would review the request application and provide access to the information under Open Data Programme.

KSRTC has implemented Intelligent Transport System (ITS) in Mysuru City with assistance from World Bank, Govt of India and Govt of Karnataka.

Under this project, commuters are provided with Expected Time of Arrivals (ETA) and Expected Time of Departure of Buses in real time. KSRTC has been providing bus related information through Passenger Information System (PIS) Display Boards, SMS, IVRS, Commuter Portal and Mobile App.
