**SUB: Hon'ble Transport Minister ordered to present the Silver Medal for 588
Accident free Drivers of the division on 26th January during Republic Day
Celebration**

KSRTC introduced the scheme of awarding Silver Medal to accident free and default free drivers during the year 1982. According to this, the drivers who have rendered 5 years accident free and default free service in rural sector are being awarded with Silver Medals.

- Silver Medal is also extended to Driver-cum-Conductors from 2016 onwards.
- The drivers are awarded with a 32 gram Silver Medal with Gandabherunda logo in the centre along with a cash reward of Rs 2,000/- considering them as "Suraksha Chalaka"
- Further, monthly allowance of Rs.50/- will also be given to motivate them to perform accident free duty

On 12.01.2018 Hon'ble Transport Minister while awarding 86 Silver Medals to Bengaluru Central Division Accident free drivers, directed to present the Silver Medal function in other divisions of KSRTC on Republic Day. i.e 26.01.2018
