KSRTC is issuing Monthly Passes to the travelling public with a view to have regular and guaranteed flow of traffic revenues. Monthly passes facilitate the regular commuters to have hassle-free travel without loss of time in purchasing tickets on daily basis.

Monthly pass rates were rationalized vide ref-14, introducing separate passes for Express and Ordinary services. After implementation, the sale of passes and revenue was reviewed. It was felt necessary to further rationalize the Monthly pass rates, to attract more regular passengers to KSRTC services. Accordingly, Monthly Pass rates are rationalized with effect from 10-12-2016 and revised pass rates are as detailed below;

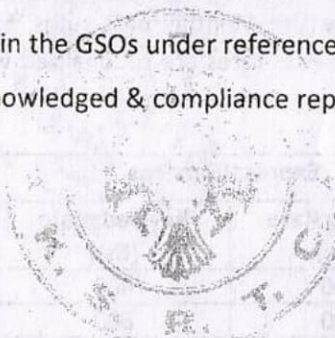

To implement the revised monthly pass rates, following instructions are given;

1. There is no change in the rates of Monthly passes for Ordinary services.
2. Monthly passes for Ordinary services shall be issued upto 10 chargeable stages only on routes where Ordinary services are in operation.
3. Passengers having/procuring Monthly passes for Ordinary services are allowed to travel in Ordinary services only.
4. Monthly passes for Express services shall be issued upto 20 chargeable stages only, on routes where Express services are in operation.
5. Passengers having/procuring Monthly passes express services are allowed to travel in both, Express and Ordinary services.
6. The existing stock of monthly passes shall be utilized by re-stamping to lower denominations, where necessary.
7. **Procedure for re-stamping:** The Unit Heads are authorized to procure rubber stamps to re-stamp the higher value monthly passes to lower value only. Further, such rubber stamps shall have the initials of the Accounts Officer of the respective Division. The work of re-stamping shall be done under the supervision of the Accounts Officer and in the presence of Security personnel.

All other conditions stipulated in the GSOs under reference remain unchanged.
